

## What are Head Start & Early Head Start?

Head Start and Early Head Start are federally funded Early Childhood Education programs, locally designed and implemented, providing quality prenatal and early childhood education to children and their families. The programs are comprehensive and involve the family in the total development of the child.

Families with children ages 0-5, and pregnant women are encouraged to apply anytime throughout the year. Families whose children have special needs are also encouraged to apply. Families must meet eligibility requirements. There is no cost for children and families who qualify for the program.

### Head Start Options

#### Center-based classrooms for 3 & 4 year olds

The program offers classroom options of 3.5 hours or 6.0 hours per day and either 4 or 5 days per week. Call the center for more information.

#### Home-based for children 3 - 4

Head Start services are offered in your home for 1.5 hours once a week, for 32 weeks. Children and families also experience a group classroom socialization.

### Early Head Start Options

#### Center-based option for 2-year-olds

This is a full year option that offers a classroom experience for the children 6 hours a day, 5 days a week. Available in Portage and Waushara counties.

#### Home-based option for pregnant moms and children ages 0-3

Early Head Start services are offered year round in your home for 1.5 hours, once a week. Children and families also experience group socializations. This option is available in Portage, Waupaca, Waushara, and Marquette counties.
