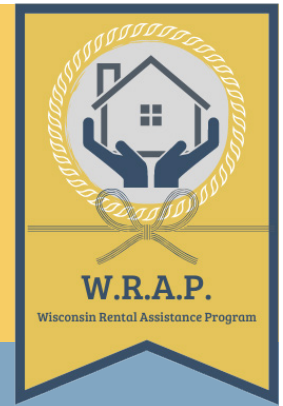


# Do you and your family owe rent as a result of COVID-19?

## Apply for the Wisconsin Rental Assistance Program (WRAP)!



### What's available?

- Up to \$1,000 per month for rent paid directly to landlord
- Up to 3 month/\$3,000 program maximum per household
- Eligible expenses: rent, back rent, security deposit, and first month's rent

### Do I qualify?

Apply for assistance through CAP Services if you answer **YES** to all of the following:

- I pay rent where I live and I have a current lease/agreement with a landlord; or I am being evicted from a rental property and am seeking a place to live that requires rent and/or a security deposit.
- I am receiving less money due to COVID-19 and I am behind in rent.
- I am not receiving any public housing assistance funding (such as a Section 8 voucher).
- I live in one of the counties listed below and my household's monthly income is at or below 80% of my county median income based on my household size.
