

Official Trivia 2021 Rules and Information

- Each team may have up to ten (10) players.
- Open to players of all ages. However, due to the nature of trivia competition, please be aware that there may be some foul language, inappropriate behavior and alcohol will be served.
- Questions will be asked in the competition room.
- Questions will be asked each hour and you will have the length of one song to answer each question.
- Teams will be provided answer sheets for each question. Teams will also be provided with pencils and scratch paper. At the end of each question, answers will be collected and brought to the scorekeeping area.
- There are no books, no computers, no phones, no ear pieces, no communication devices or any other items we deem undesirable allowed in the competition room.
- Breaks will be given, and at that time you will be allowed to check phones that are in your vehicle.
- **REPEAT: ABSOLUTELY NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES ALLOWED IN THE COMPETITION ROOM.** If a phone rings, your team will be disqualified.
- The members at the table can talk amongst themselves to discuss the answer. No outside help is allowed.
- At the end of each question, the question and answer will be read, and the next question will be asked.
- If you leave the competition room during a question, you may only re-enter upon the end of that question.
- No players allowed in the competition room without a team badge. Team badges will be given to you once your team is registered.
- The competition room will be monitored for any violations of these rules. You will have the choice to comply with the rules or leave the competition room.
 - **No carry INS allowed in the competition room.**

Trivia will begin at 5:00pm and last until 9:00pm. All proceeds will go to CAP Services Domestic Abuse Outreach Office for Waushara County. Team registration in advance is preferred. Registration on the day of the event will be limited to the amount of available space and seating. **The cost is \$150.00 per team.**

Registration forms will be available online at www.capservices.org or picked up at the CAPsell Building at 205 E. Main Street. Forms may be filled out and mailed, along with registration fee, to **CAP Services, Waushara County DV Office, 205 E. Main Street, Suite 12, Wautoma, WI 54982.** On October 9th, registration will begin at 4:00 pm and ends at 4:30 pm. At 4:40 pm, the competition room will be opened and teams may find their tables. Again, players may not enter the competition room without a team badge.

Team totals will be announced at the beginning of each hour after the break. At the end of the contest, there will be an awards presentation and mixer. The competition will be family oriented and questions will test what you know, not what you can Google.
